

































Getting started/Machine operation

<p>Control Panel MAIN SCREEN</p> <p style="text-align: center;">→</p>		<p>IMPORTING DESIGN FROM USB:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ◆ Select  to import design from Disk. ◆ U. Des. Input (5)  ◆ From design menu use ▼▲ from key pad to scroll through designs. ◆ Once design is “highlighted” select  ◆ Filt Empty Sti? (No)  ◆ Give design a memory number or let the machine designate one for you.  ◆ Give design a name/use machine default.  ◆ Keep inputting? Select No, then  ◆ Parameters menu, Select <i>work order</i>. Scroll down ▼ or 9 on key pad then  ◆ Select colors: 1-9 or 10 & 0 for 10, 10 & 1 for 11 and so on. The number in () on the left tells you what number you are entering a color for. ◆ Once you are finished in this screen, press the  key. ◆ Circulate the setting? Yes/No then . Select (YES) to keep the setting for that design and (NO) if you do not want the settings saved for this design. ◆ Back at the “Main Control Panel” change  embroidery status to preparation status (light goes off) & “Quit Embroidery?” box comes up. Select YES then . Now you can trace the design... ◆ <u>BEFORE</u> tracing, select your needle #1 on the key pad, and then use your ▼▲ keys to align the needle when your embroidery needs to be. ◆ Select  from your key pad, select #5 “Frame Range” and . Des. Range comes up, down at the bottom “Pull Bar to Start” press the start  button and watch design trace. After design trace, select the  button to go back to control panel. ◆ Almost there... Now, select your EMBROIDERY STATUS button . When the light is back on, you are ready to begin sewing out your design. ◆ Last step... 
<p>IMPORTING DESIGN FROM MEMORY:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ◆ Use your  to select design in memory. ◆ Option 1 – Select Design  ◆ Enter design number or press the  key for the menu. ◆ From here, scroll through the designs to find the one you are looking for. <p>NOTICE that when you scroll, the design that is highlighted appears at the bottom left hand corner.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ◆ Press  to select the design. ◆ Parameters menu, Select <i>work order</i>. Scroll down ▼ or 9 on key pad then  ◆ Select colors: 1-9 or 10 & 0 for 10, 10 & 1 for 11 and so on. The number in () on the left tells you what number you are entering a color for. ◆ Once you are finished in this screen, press the  key. ◆ Back at the “Main Control Panel” change  embroidery status to preparation status (light goes off) & “Quit Embroidery?” box comes up.
